

PASSENGER CHARTER,

THE FOLLOWING ARE : SAFETY & ENVIRONMENTAL RULES

Les llots de Gruissan are located in the heart of the Marina where the port rules apply. This particular environment requires that you respect a certain number of rules that we bring to your attention.

We thank you for taking the time to read them before entering your LodgeBoat.



Swimming is forbidden in the area of les îlots de Gruissan.



Movement and activities on the pontoons. For the comfort and safety of all, it is forbidden to:

- Running on the pontoons.
- Playing ball games, beach games, or any other activity that may disturb the peace and quiet of other passengers.
- Pushing people in the water.
- Move on the pontoon on bikes, scooters or any other vehicle.

The LodgeBoats :

• The LodgeBoats are moored to the quay by ropes and are regularly checked to ensure that all their equipment is in perfect working order. The ropes have been professionally adjusted, so it is strictly forbidden to touch them.

In case you notice a defect on an equipment, we thank you not to intervene directly but to let it know to the Captain of the site who will take all necessary measures to correct the situation as soon as possible.

• Smoking and lighting candles in the LodgeBoats is prohibited. Apart from the services offered by a professional, the use of BBQs is strictly forbidden on board.

Preservation of the environment:

- Cigarette butts must be extinguished and disposed of in a trash can.
- In general, it is forbidden to throw fluids or waste into the water.
- The port is a natural and sensitive environment, also we invite you to have a reasonable use of water and electricity resources and to consume only the quantity necessary for your use.

Accessibility: The LodgeBoats have been designed to be accessible to a wide public in complete safety. However, the specificities of the port environment require special attention for the following populations :

- Children : The site of les llots de Gruissan is accessible to children who remain during their stay under the entire responsibility of their parents. The children who stay at the site of les îlots of Gruissan must know how to swim. A certificate will be given to you upon your arrival to confirm that your child(ren) know how to swim. If necessary, safety armbands will be given to the children. They must wear them at all times when moving around the site. Parents are responsible for wearing the armbands.
- People with Reduced Mobility: Access to the LodgeBoats is via a walkway that is dependent on the water level, with an uncontrolled slope of the tide. We are currently working with an association to study the next adaptations necessary to guarantee access on board for People with Reduced Mobility, regardless of the tidal level. While waiting for these evolutions, our crew is at your disposal to facilitate your access on board as much as possible.
- Our friends the dogs and cats are allowed on board! Dogs and cats are allowed on board with an extra charge (only category 1 and 2 dogs are forbidden). Your dogs must be kept on a leash within les îlots de Gruissan, no droppings or urine are allowed on the pontoons and terraces of the LodgeBoat. Any damage to LodgeBoats will be the responsibility of the owner, and pets must not be left unattended on site (in the Lodgeboat or in a car). In the event of damage caused by an animal, the customer will be asked to pay a minimum of €50 fifty in compensation.
